Waste Collection Over the Festive Season

Town's Festive Season Opening Hours

Swan River Crossings Project

Did you know? An enhanced design for a new bridge to replace the Fremantle Traffic Bridge has been submitted by Main Roads for Development Approval (DA). The new design, developed in response to community feedback, no longer proposes any changes to the existing road layout. Key features of the new bridge include:

- Two traffic lanes in each direction for road users
- Ties into Canning Highway intersection to the south
- Wider and safer pedestrian and cyclist paths on each side of the new bridge (up to 4 metres wide).
