2022 Addendum to the Niergarup Track East Fremantle Three Year Management Plan Prepared for the Town of East Fremantle in August 2020

A walk was held at the track on Saturday March 19<sup>th</sup> 2022 to obtain feedback from the public on the management plan. This was attended by the public, APACE WA and East Fremantle Council.

Following this, the East Fremantle Council have suggested some changes in the plant choices for the winter planting season, including to limit plant heights to 2.5m or less. The updated plant list is provided in Table 1.
