

# What goes in the recycling bin?

**Glass Bottles and Jars:**

- ✓ Beer bottles
- ✓ Broken glass (not mirrors)
- ✓ Coffee jars
- ✓ Sauce and wine bottles (lids off)

**Plastic Bottles and Containers:**

- ✓ Plastic containers from kitchen (rinsed and clean) i.e. sauce bottles
- ✓ Plastic containers from laundry (rinsed and clean) i.e. detergent bottles
- ✓ Plastic containers from bathroom (rinsed and clean) i.e. shampoo bottles
- ✓ Take-away food containers (rinsed not polystyrene) (lids off)

**Paper and Cardboard:**

- ✓ Cardboard (flattened)
- ✓ Paper (not shredded)
- ✓ Letters and junk mail

**Steel and Aluminium Cans:**

- ✓ Aluminium cans
- ✓ Coffee and milo tins
- ✓ Jar lids
- ✓ Food tins (rinsed)

Preferably take all your soft plastic e.g. bread bags, chip packets and plastic bags to REDcycle bins at major supermarkets. For more information on REDcycle see [www.redcycle.net.au](http://www.redcycle.net.au)

## These items don't belong in this bin:



**NO tied bags or liners**



**NO nappies**



**NO food waste**



**NO garden waste**



**NO polystyrene or soft plastics**

- ✗ NO aerosols
- ✗ NO batteries
- ✗ NO meat trays
- ✗ NO shredded paper
- ✗ NO soft plastic:
  - bread bags
  - chip packets
  - lolly wrappers
  - plastic bags
