THANK YOU MAYOR, FOR THAT WARM WELCOME.

WHAT A WONDERFUL DAY IT IS, TO BE WITH YOU ALL IN THIS PLACE, WHICH IN TERMS OF RACING IS **HALLOWED GROUND.** 

**RICHMOND RACEWAY**, A HORSE AND HARNESS RACING TRACK, WAS ESTABLISHED HERE IN 1928 AND RAN UNTIL IT CLOSED IN 1991.

A LITTLE HISTORY OF WHAT IS NOW **RICHMOND RACEWAY,**WHICH HAS BEEN HOME TO MANY ACTIVITIES:

THE AREA WAS A MUNICIPAL RESERVE FROM 1913 – 1927 AND THE PARK WAS ORIGINALLY KNOWS AS THE POLO GROUND, THEN USED AS A FOOTBALL OVAL, A GENERAL PLAYING FIELD AND USED BY THE FREMANTLE GYMKHANA UNTIL FREMANTLE TROTTING CLUB BOUGHT IT IN 1917 AND DEVELOPED IT AS A TROTTING RACEWAY.

THE TROTTING WAS ALSO INTERUPTED FROM **1942-1949**DURING THE 2<sup>ND</sup> WORLD WAR, WHEN **RICHMOND PARK** AND
THE EAST **FREMANTLE OVAL** WERE USED BY THE **US ARMED FORCES** AS A GENERAL MILITARY BASE AND BY THE AUSTRALIAN'S AS AN **ANTI-AIRCRAFT DEFENCE FACILITY**.

I AM SURE, MANY OF YOU WHO LIVE HERE NOW AND THOSE WHO DID PREVIOUSLY, WILL REMEMBER THE SOUND OF HORSES HOOVES THUNDERING AROUND THE TRACK ON FRIDAY NIGHTS – AS A HORSE LOVER MYSELF, I CERTAINLY DO REMEMBER THOSE SOUNDS.

HOWEVER, NOW IT IS A QUIET PARK SURROUNDED BY TREES AND HOUSES, ONCE A VIBRANT MECCA FOR LOVERS OF HORSES AND HARNESS RACING.

THE ONCE ATMOSPHERE WAS ELECTRIC WITH ANTICIPATION.

THROUGH THESE **TURNSTILES D**RESSED IN THEIR SUNDAY BEST, SPORTING HATS AND GLOVES, WITH FORM GUIDES HELD TIGHT IN THEIR HANDS AND THE PROMISE OF A FUN OUTING LAY AHEAD NO MATTER WHAT THE RESULT.

WOULD THEIR HORSE BE FIRST ACROSS THE LINE?
WOULD THEIR FAVOURITE REINSMEN TAKE HIM THERE?

TALKING ABOUT HORSES ACROSS THE LINE, YOU MAY KNOW WE HAVE DEPICTED **10** HORSES IN OUR ARTWORK ON THE TURNSTYLES AND ALTHOUGH I CAN'T RUN THROUGH THEM ALL, I AM PLEASE TO SAY, WE DO HAVE REPRESENTATIVES OF SOME OF THESE GREAT HORSES HERE TODAY, AND I WOULD LIKE TO INDULGE YOU BY INTRODUCING THEM...

## **VILLAGE KID:**

IAM NOT TOO SURE WHERE TO START WITH VILLAGE KID, IN HIS BOOK THERE ARE 2 PAGES OF WINNINGS AND AWARDS WHICH INCLUDE AN INTER DOMINION, AUSTRALIAN PACING CHAMPIONSHIP, 3 WA HARNESS HORSE OF THE YEAR AND MORE.

OWNER/TRAINER OF VILLAGE KID BILL AND NORMA HORN AND DRIVER/REINSMAN CHRIS LEWIS –

By the way Chris is still racing at Gloucester park

ALSO CO-OWNER OF VILLAGE KID WAS NO LESS THAN GORDON COX, GORDON WAS THE OWNER AND MANUFACTURER OF 'BURLEY' FOOTBALLS.....

## **SAN SIMEON:**

THEN THERE IS THE GREAT SAN SIMEON WHO WON 29

STRAIGHT RACES AND THE INTER DIMINION.

SAN SIMEON WAS OWNED BY LYALL AND FRAN PORTER AND WE ARE LUCKY TO HAVE FRAN PORTER WITH US HERE TODAY AND HIS DRIVER LOU AUSTIN.

## **DAINTY'S DAUGHTER:**

ONE OF AUSTRALIA'S **GREATEST MARES**, SHE HELD WORLD RECORDS OVER ONE AND TWO MILES AND WAS THE **FIRST WESTERN AUSTRALIAN HORSE** INVITED INTO THE **NSW MIRACLE MILE** AND DAINTYS DAUGHTER BECAME THE FIRST MARE INDUCTED INTO **THE WEST AUSTRALIA RACING INDUSTRY HALL OF FAME.** 

DAINTY'S DAUGHTER WAS TRAINED AND DRIVEN BY
BERNIE CUSHING FOR HER OWNER/BREEDER JOCK
COLEMAN, AND WE HAVE DOT PARKER BERNIE'S
YOUNGEST DAUGHTER HERE TODAY ALSO.

SPEEDY CHEVAL'S TRAINER - ROSS OLIVIERI AND I BELLIEVE THE LAST RACE WAS WON BY SPEEDY CHEVAL ON THE 12<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 1991. Correct Ross and did you drive her that day???

DURING THOSE 63 YEARS, THIS NOBLE SPORT BROUGHT GREAT DELIGHT TO THOSE WHO TOOK PART AND THOSE WHO WATCHED IT, AND THIS PLACE DREW PATRONS FROM THROUGHOUT PERTH AND BEYOND.

THIS WAS PARTICULARY SO IN THE 1950S WHEN THE "SWEEP" TOOK PLACE. OUR HISTORIAN, ALLAN PARKER SAID THE SWEEP INVOLVED CHOOSING THE WINNERS OF THE LAST 5 RACES, AND IF YOU WON, YOU WON APPROX £92,000 – A HUGE SUM EQUATING TO MILLIONS TODAY.

ALTHOUGH THE HORSES NO LONGER RUN HERE, THE TURNSTILES REMAIN, AND SO DO THE NAMES OF HORSES RECALLED IN LOCAL STREETS, AND NOW WE HAVE THESE NEW VISUAL RECORDS OF THIS AREA'S RACING HISTORY.

THIS BRINGS ME TO A VEY IPORTANT PART OF THE DAY
.....ON BEHALF OF THE MAYOR AND MY FELLOW
COUNCILLORS, I WOULD PARTICULARLY LIKE TO GIVE OUR
THANKS TO BEN AND TONY JONES WHOSE PASSION, SKILL
AND SERIOUS CRAFTSMANSHIP HAVE RENDERED THESE
STUNNING IMAGES THAT ARE NOW A PERMANENT FIXTURE
IN THIS AREA TO COMMERATE RICHMOND RACEWAY

WE AREA VERY PROUD OF **BEN'S "CUSTOMISING**" OF EACH WINDOW, WITH ALMOST A PORTRAIT OF EACH HORSE, DRIVER AND IT'S HISTORY. FRAN PORTER, ACTUALLY MENTIONED TO ME, SHE COULDN'T BELIEVE HOW MUCH THE DEPICTION OF LOU AUSTIN ACTUALLY LOOKED LIKE HIM IN THE PANEL - WELL DONE BEN, THANK YOU.

ALSO, TO MATT HASTIE FROM MARGARET RIVER STEEL WHO DID A GREAT JOB WITH THE TRICKY MEASUREMENTS AND ACCURATE FABRICCATION OF THEM ALL.

WE WOULD ALSO LIKE TO THANK **MILTON JAMES**, ALLEN PARKER AND ROSS PYKE FOR THEIR INVALUABLE GUIDANCE AND ADVICE ASSITING **TONY AND BEN** IN THE MAKING OF THESE PANELS.

THE **TOWN OF EAST FREMANTLE** IS PROUD TO INVEST IN HERITAGE AND IN PUBLIC ART, AND I WOULD LIKE TO THANK THE COUNCIL'S PUBLIC ART COMMITTEE AND STAFF IN THE TIME THEY HAVE ALL PUT INTO THESE ARTWORKS COMING TO FRUITION.

FOR SOME FUN OF THE PAST, I WOULD LIKE TO INTRODUCE YOU TO OUR **RACE CALLER** HERE TODAY, IN **HAYDEN KING**TO CALL A RACE **ONE LAST TIME** OF THESE TEN **FAMOUS HORSES** DEPICTED IN THE WINDOWS OF THE TURNSTYLES.
